Provide direct patient care of varying complexity, utilising the nursing process and incorporating a risk assessment approach while working within the prescribed legislation. 2. Be responsible for providing direct guidance to a delegated number of new and / or less experienced staff to achieve and agreed standard of care by: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Planning and co-ordinating the continuum of care • Assisting in the orientation, education and preceptorship of staff and students • Acting a team leader or CNC as required. 3. Act as a professional role model and resource person, providing guidance and leadership in provision of patient care. Liaise within the multi-disciplinary care team, actively participating in identifying and communicating patient needs at all points of the care continuum. 4. Provide patient information and education throughout the continuum of care to patients and their families. 5. Undertake unit clinical research, quality improvement and procedure development. 6. Use computerised patient information and other PC based systems to obtain patient and other general information. 7. Take responsibility for own continuing professional development, competency assessment and appraisal. 8. Demonstrate Calvary's values in daily work practices
